Rehabilitation Division Bureau of Vocational Rehabilitation

The Bureau of Vocational Rehabilitation works with high school students who have disabilities and are transitioning to post-secondary education and/or employment. The program is a collaborative effort with the student, family and school staff. Vocational Rehabilitation services are available for students whose disabilities result in a substantial barrier to employment. The program is for students with different types of disabilities and not just for those who are enrolled in special education classes



Vocational Rehabilitation Services

Students are encouraged to begin the transition process during the last two years of high school.

Services are individualized and may include:

- Assessments to determine job-related skills and abilities
- Consultations: IEP meeting for transition planning
- Career Counseling and guidance
- Assistive Technology
- On-the-job training
- Financial assistance for college and trade school
- Job placement
- Job coaching
