Henderson Nevada JobConnect Gets New Digs

New Location at 4500 Sunset Road, Henderson

Henderson, NV —The Henderson location of the Nevada JobConnect will relocate to 4500 Sunset Road Suite 40, Henderson, NV. The new location will open for business at 8 a.m. on April 28, 2015. The current location, at 119 Water Street, Henderson will close permanently at 5 p.m. on April 23, 2015, said Renee Olson, administrator for the Employment Security Division of the Department of Employment, Training and Rehabilitation, which oversees Nevada JobConnect.

“This is an exciting opportunity for Nevada JobConnect to improve the outstanding service that the Henderson community has come to enjoy,” Olson said. “The new office is more spacious and centrally located near major bus lines. It will offer the same highly-qualified dedicated team that will be able to better keep up with the demand of Henderson’s growing population of jobseekers and businesses.”

The new office is on the corner of Sunset Road and Mountain Vista in Green Valley’s bustling Town Center. While the Henderson office is closed for relocation, jobseekers and businesses are directed to utilize the other two Southern Nevada JobConnect locations at 3405 South Maryland Parkway, Las Vegas and 2827 Las Vegas Boulevard, North Las Vegas, Olson said.

Nevada JobConnect provides employment-related services at no cost to jobseekers and businesses. Job Seeker services include referrals to jobs, job boards, on-line jobs data base, resume-writing assistance, referrals for job training programs, resource centers with computers, and dedicated employment services for Veterans and people with disabilities.

Businesses can take advantage of services such as hiring event/job fair assistance, recruitment, applicant pre-screening, assessments, access to Nevada’s largest database of qualified job seekers, Silver State Works business incentives, labor market and economic information, and training resources.
