Nevada JobConnect and the Boulevard Mall to Host Holiday Hiring Job Fair

LAS VEGAS, NV — Nevada JobConnect will partner with the Boulevard Mall to host a holiday hiring job fair Oct. 22, 2016 from 10 a.m. to 1 p.m. in the entrance of the mall by Goodwill. The mall is located at 3528 South Maryland Parkway, Las Vegas, NV.

Retail businesses located in the mall, as well as other non-retail businesses will participate, hiring fulltime, part-time, permanent and seasonal workers. Jobseekers will be interviewed on the spot and should come dressed appropriately with plenty of resumes, said Renee Olson, administrator for the Employment Security Division of Nevada's Department of Employment, Training and Rehabilitation.

"We are pleased to partner with the Boulevard Mall in hosting a job fair again this year," Olson said. "Last year's fair was extremely successful as many jobseekers were hired for seasonal and permanent employment. Jobseekers should be encouraged by the improving job market throughout the state. DETR economists project thousands of jobs to be available this holiday season. Additionally the state has added back all of the jobs, plus more, that were lost during the recession."

Some of the available positions include sales associates, window installer, hair stylists, warehouse scanners, electricians, laborers, convention attendants, grocery clerks, security officers, and food servers. Some of the businesses participating include, Sutherland Global, Manpower, UPS, US Foods, JC Penney, Goodwill, H&R Block, Sears and UPS.



DETR is comprised of the Employment Security Division, Equal Rights Commission, Rehabilitation Division, and the Research and Analysis Bureau. DETR oversees the Nevada JobConnect System to provide training and job placement services to job seekers and to assist employers in hiring practices. It also supports economic development efforts through improving Nevada's workforce.
