America's Job Bank To Be Replaced with America's Job Exchange

Effective July 1, the U.S. Department of Labor will discontinue America's Job Bank. The Department of Employment, Training & Rehabilitation (DETR) has selected America's Job Exchange as its new nationwide labor exchange and résumé posting service. America's Job Exchange will have the same service features as America's Job Bank.

"We want this to be a seamless process for employers and job seekers," said Cindy Jones, Administrator for DETR's Employment Security Division. "We want to ensure that our clients still have access to easy and convenient methods for posting and searching jobs."

Additionally, DETR's statewide job bank remains active. The statewide job bank openings are printed and made available for job seekers to read. As an added bonus to the employer, staff lists those job postings on the national job bank, soon to be America's Job Exchange.

"For employers who prefer more personalized service, we encourage them to list their postings with the statewide job bank, which offers maximum exposure to jobseekers," Jones said.

Employers who list their jobs with the state job bank work directly with an Employer Services Representative who actively helps to fill the opening.

Employers may list their job openings with any Nevada JobConnect office in the state by posting them on-line at www.detr.state.nv.us/es/es_job_order.htm. They may also call, fax, or e-mail the job openings to any JobConnect location. The contact information for the JobConnect offices may be found at www.nvdetr.org or www.NevadaJobConnect.com. For employers who do not have access to the Internet, they may call or fax their openings at: Southern Nevada: Phone: (702) 486-0129; Fax: (702) 486-7914; Northern Nevada: Phone: (775) 834-1970; Fax: (775) 688-1279.

As for America's Job Exchange, DETR is exploring the possibility of automatically transferring current job postings from America's Job Bank to America's Job Exchange, which is hosted by a private entity and is not funded by the Department of Labor.
