Demand Occupations

I. Introduction: [134(d)(4)(A)(iii) and §663.310(c)]

Section 134(d)(4)(A)(iii) requires that individuals eligible for training services must select programs of training services that are directly linked to the employment opportunities in the local area involved or in another area to which they are willing to relocate. All training must occur within the industry sectors approved by the Governor's Workforce Investment Board in accordance with the Governor's Executive Order 2012 – 18, item 1.

II. Verification:

- A. At least one of the following sources must be used to document occupations that are directly linked to employment opportunities in the local area or in another area where the customer is willing to relocate:
1. Demand occupations listing published by the Department of Employment, Training, and Rehabilitation or from appropriate state agency where the individual is willing to relocate;
 2. Training agreement signed by the employer;
 3. Local want ads indicating at least three openings;
 4. Letter or telephone contact with employers; or
 5. Three job order searches documented in the Services comment's section of Nevada JobConnect Operating System (NJCOS).
- B. For individuals willing to relocate, a written statement from the customer indicating their willingness to relocate must accompany documentation from paragraph A above.
